StGiles speech pathologists welcome a donation of \$3000 from Tattsbet which they will put towards building the organisation's ability to help adults and children with communication challenges.

Today (Friday) the team accepted \$3000 from Tattsbet Tasmanian manager Chris Edwards.

Each year StGiles six speech pathologists see around 500 children. StGiles is the largest public provider of speech pathology in Northern Tasmania with an average waiting time of 12 months and 65 children currently on the waiting list.

The team, which last week won a national award for its ground breaking program LAMP (Language Acquisition through Motor Planning), will use the donation to build on its technology base.
