TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF NICHE MARKET BAZAAR PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- A deposit of \$50 is due 14 days after receiving your acceptance email, OR, your place will be allocated to another applicant. No refunds are given for cancellation or withdrawal.
- Each stallholder agrees to pay 20 per cent of their total sales including orders to StGiles Society within 14 days of the Niche market, less their \$50 deposit. StGiles will provide a tax receipt for your donation.
- Unsuccessful applications will NOT be notified but will be placed on the waiting list.
- Sites will be allocated based on availability. If a stallholder withdraws, reallocation will be made by selection from the waiting list.
- Each stall is approximately 3m wide. Stallholders MUST provide their own table and all elements required to do business.
- Stalls must be set up and ready to go 15 minutes before the market commences.
- · Valuables, floats and electronic payment facilities are stallholder's own responsibility.
- Stallholders are to provide their own packaging, business cards and leaflets.
- It is strongly recommended that stallholders arrange their own public liability insurance and hold a stallholders current policy of product liability insurance cover.
- StGiles, or any of its representatives, will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to person or property, however caused, including the negligence of the market or its representatives or agents including loss of damage arising out of weather or cancellation of the event. Fees are not refundable.
- Sharing of stalls is permitted if an application form has been submitted together.
- All photos submitted with your application form may be used by StGiles in marketing material. Do not send more than 3 photos. Electronic photos only accepted.
- The number of markets per stallholder each year is not limited, but based on product demand and variety of stalls.
- Stallholders must not commence packing up until after the market has closed, even if they are sold-out.
- Stallholders are not accepted if they have a shop or if they are attending another market in Launceston/Burnie on the same day.
